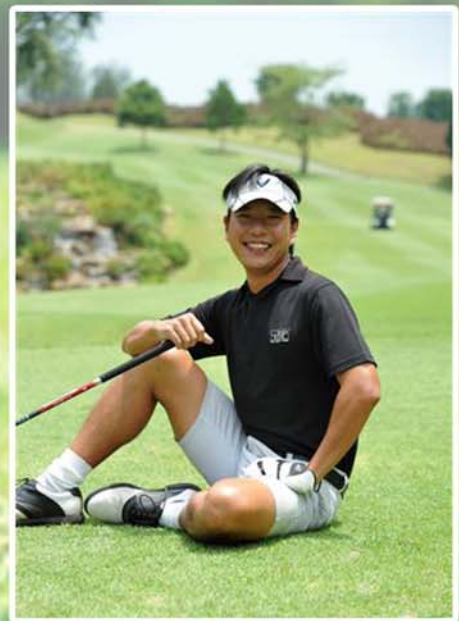


Singapore Press Club - CIMB Golf Classic 2013

This year, the event was renamed the Singapore Press Club-CIMB Golf Classic with CIMB assuming the title sponsor post for the next three years.
